Michael John Salvo, 73, passed away peacefully on April 20, 2022 with his wife by his side. He was born to John G Salvo and Mary N Salvo (Luongo) on June 30, 1948 in Cambridge, Massachusetts. He is survived by his loving wife Patricia Salvo (Murphy) with whom he was married to for 27 years, his son Evan W Salvo and his wife Erika Salvo of Coventry, RI and their two children Maia and Marlee Salvo, his daughter Maia Strobe and her husband Matthew Strobe of Gladwyne, PA and their three children, Stella, Archie and Kit Strobe. Michael graduated from Belmont High School in Belmont, Massachusetts in 1966 and went on to attend college at Boston College and Northeastern University.

This was where he fell back in love with Maine having spent much of his earlier life there raising his children. In his later years, he rekindled his love for the theatre working at both Trinity Repertory Theatre in Providence, RI and at Theatre by The Sea in South Kingstown, RI. Lastly he worked for a non-profit organization called Books are Wings whose sole mission is to provide all children with regular access to free books.

Michael was a lifelong lover of the theatre. He was involved in many aspects including acting on stage, set-building and managing the house.

He was an avid bird watcher and gardener and enjoyed spending time outside. He was a great lover of books and history and thoroughly enjoyed reading to his children when they were young and later to his five grandchildren. Michael was an incredibly kind man and always made sure to make others feel warm and welcome in his presence. He was witty and smart with an infectious spirit and was always good for a laugh. He will be sorely missed.
