Carl Norcross was born in Queens New York in 1950 and was raised in New York and Connecticut. He received his bachelor's degree at Tulane University where he was enrolled in the Navy ROTC and after graduating continued on in the Navy for eight years. Carl left the military after receiving his masters degree from George Washington University and spent his career working as an HR director specializing in high-tech start-ups, moving from Texas, to California, to Colorado, and eventually Rhode Island. He joined the Federal Government as a civilian employee and worked for the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration and the Department of Veterans Affairs prior to retiring in 2015.
