Christopher Robinson Reddick, 53, passed away July 14, 2022.

Born in Syracuse, New York on July 11, 1969 he was a son of George L. Reddick of Florida and Meredith Johnson of North Kingstown, RI; brother of Michael Tibbetts of North Kingstown, RI, Todd Josh of Illinois, Kevin Reddick of New York, George Reddick of New York and the late Lori and Eric Reddick; father of Sheila Rivera, Andrea Reddick, Tyler Reddick, Valencia Reddick, Christopher Reddick and Chace Reddick all of Newport, RI; step-father of Tassia O'neal of Tennessee. Christopher also leaves several grandchildren, nieces and nephews.

Chris joined the United States Marine Corps in July of 1987. During his time with the Marines, he served a two year tour as Security Forces in Cecil Field, Florida and a two year tour as Infantry Soldier at Camp Lejeune in North Carolina. This included an 8 month deployment to Desert Storm. He was Honorably discharged in 1991 from the Marines.

In February of 2001, Chris joined the RI Army National Guard and retired in January of 2019. At the time of retirement, he was a 1st Sergeant with the 43rd Military Police Brigade. During his time with the RI Army National Guard, Chris worked with the 115th and 169th Military Police Companies with 2 combat tours in Iraq (2003 and 2007), 1 combat tour in Afghanistan (2012)

and was Awarded Bronze Star for meritorious service in 2012.

Chris was employed at Toray Plastics for the past 24 years.

Funeral service and burial will be held in the Rhode Island Veterans Memorial Cemetery, 301 South County Trail, Exeter on Wednesday, August 3rd at 11:30 AM. Please meet at the administration building to line up for procession at 11:00 AM.
