The most striking features for me were her eyes and her smile.

We learned to Trust each other, to value the strengths each had and listen to the counsel of the other. In short order we began working together as a team.

Life got better and better.

Jane and I both entered our relationship with scars. We were both keenly aware of them and we both tried to find ways to help our partner heal.

We discussed everything; I never made a decision without JANE. We did not always agree, sometimes we had to revisit topics multiple times, but we found compromise.

We shared everything and eventually through Trust, and Love, Commitment & Respect, Jane healed my heart, and somehow, I healed hers.

From the beginning I was incredibly humbled and honored to have her by my side. I thanked God daily that Jane was in my life. Neither of us missed an opportunity to express our Love.

Sometime after we became engaged, I started asking Jane if she was still my girl.

She would answer “Yes, I am your Girl”, or “Always” or “Who else could I belong to”. That continued throughout our time together.

We shared a commitment to each other in all things economic, emotional and psychological. We developed short- and long-term goals and worked toward achieving them in unison. If we hit road blocks, we found a way around. Through it all we supported each other and respected one another’s needs & wishes. Together we grew. I know Jane made me a better person.

We worried about each other and we guarded our Partners most precious identity. Our one True Heart.

Jane and I have 2 wonderful caring children. Jeffrey & Stephanie.

We loved each other’s children and thought of them as our own. We worried about them and shared our fears. We have always been proud of them, but never more proud, than now.

We were together for almost 21 years. Engaged for 20 years and lived in Warwick for 19.

We rebuilt and built a home in a wonderful neighborhood where we met more incredible people in one square mile than we could ever imagine we would have the privilege of knowing.

We were humbled when people offered to help with our projects or readily came to lend a hand when asked.

When Jane got sick the Love and Caring we experienced from our friends and neighbors literally crushed our emotions.

We had a steel resolve to fight the Cancer that was attacking MY JANE. We dedicate all of our resource and energy to extending her life and finding a cure. Jane, MY JANE was very Brave, she fought so hard.

We did very well at keeping the Cancer at bay, but she never got a break and while we won many battles, we lost in the end.

What neither she or I were prepared for was the outpouring of Emotional Support and Love from the Friends and Neighbors we had come love over the years.

She wanted to thank you all, from Family to Neighbors to Work friends, and Friends, to Doctors and Nurses who truly cared.

I can tell you that every one of you had a very special place in Janes heart, and in mine, because we share the same heart.

Jane was my Partner in all things, I Trusted her with Everything I had and Everything I was. She was the Woman I dreamed of.

The Strong Woman with whom I shared everything. The Woman whose Empathy healed me, whose Love made my life easy and who walked through Life with me. Beside me as an Equal.

This is our story. Our very personal Love Story of A life built on Love, Respect, Trust and Commitment.

As Jane says goodbye to us and we say goodbye to her.

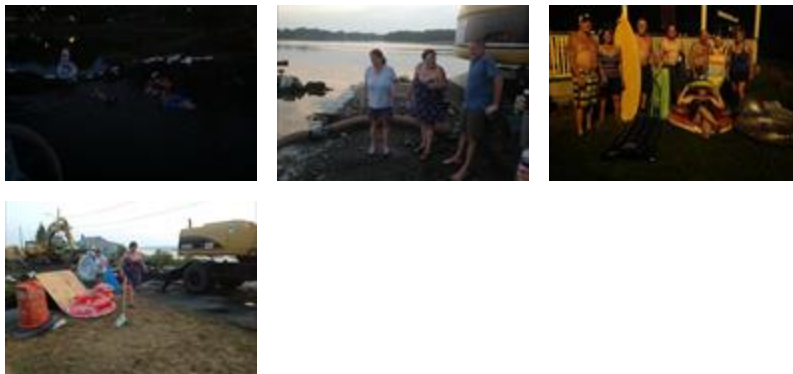

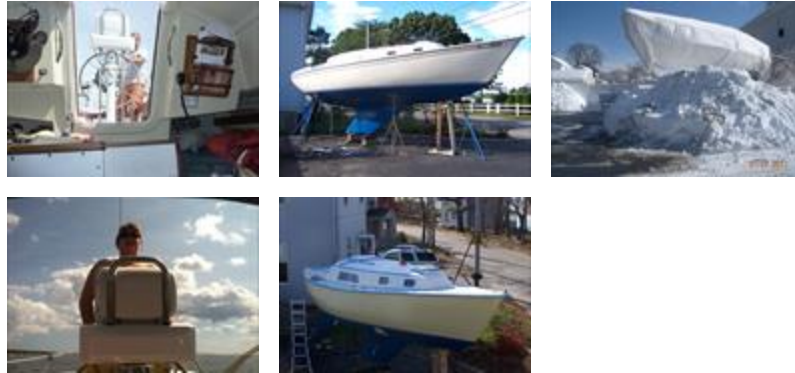

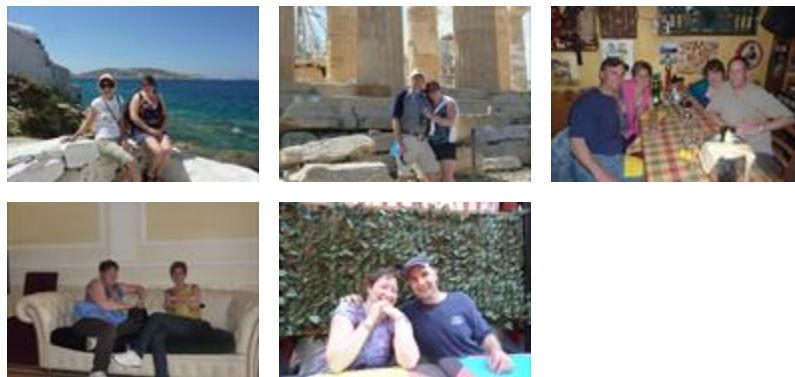
