Judith Dennis Hertzler, 60, passed away July 22, 2022, after a long battle with breast cancer.

Judy was born in Garden Grove, California, to USMC Colonel Richard Leigh Dennis and Carolyn Bacon Chellis. She was the sister of Richard Leigh Dennis Jr. and Jane Sansum. She was the devoted mother of Elizabeth Hertzler and her fiancé Matthew Roth. She also leaves many dear friends, including two nieces—Kellye Austin and Laura Sansum—and two nephews—Richard Leigh Dennis III and Ralph Sansum.

Judy was a brilliant mind and passionate political advocate. She graduated Portsmouth High School in 1980 after being elected class president in her senior year. She went on to study at Providence College and graduated with a degree in political science in 1984. Afterwards, Judy went on to work at the Rhode Island State House, with prominent administrative contributions to several political campaigns, most notably Kathleen Connell's RI Secretary of State campaign, and Steven Archambault's 2010 bid for the RI Attorney General seat. After leaving the State House, Judy also assisted Rhoda Perry during her term on the Rhode Island Senate, and subsequently worked for Johnson and Johnson in their DePuy Spine Institute from 2009-2015.

Outside of work, Judy had a great love of the sea. She spent much of her

childhood on sailboats, with her best friend Kathy Belanger-Barber. Judy was married to Richard Hertzler for fifteen years, and after they separated she moved to Barrington with her daughter Elizabeth. She remained a resident throughout her breast cancer diagnosis and treatment until her passing.
