



## Raymond Thomas Lisi

Raymond T Lisi, 86 of North Kingstown, RI. Passed away peacefully at South County Hospital in Wakefield on January 30, 2026. Born in New York City, August 21, 1939, Ray joined the US Navy when he was seventeen, and retired in 1975 as a petty officer(E6). He served aboard the USS Great Sitkin, USS Howard W Gilmore and USS Requisite. While serving in Groton, Connecticut Raymond became a Technical Illustrator, a trade which served him well in civilian life, as a draftsman for Goodyear. After the service he worked as a bartender for Carriage Inn, Carter's 19th Hole and Top of the Dock. Ray also worked at Walmart in North Kingstown, and Dave's Marketplace in Wickford. In his formative years, Ray was lucky enough to attend baseball games at: Ebbets Field, home of the Brooklyn Dodgers; Yankee Stadium, home of the Yankees; and Polo Grounds, home of the Mets. He would often share his knowledge of the sport, which inspired him a book about the Brooklyn Dodgers.

Raymond was the husband of Joan Lisi, who predeceased him in 2014. He is survived by his stepsons James Ferguson(Joyce) and Theodore Ferguson(Anna), And stepdaughter Dorothy Silva(Carlos). He also leaves behind Four grandchildren and four great grandchildren. At his request there will be no memorial service.
